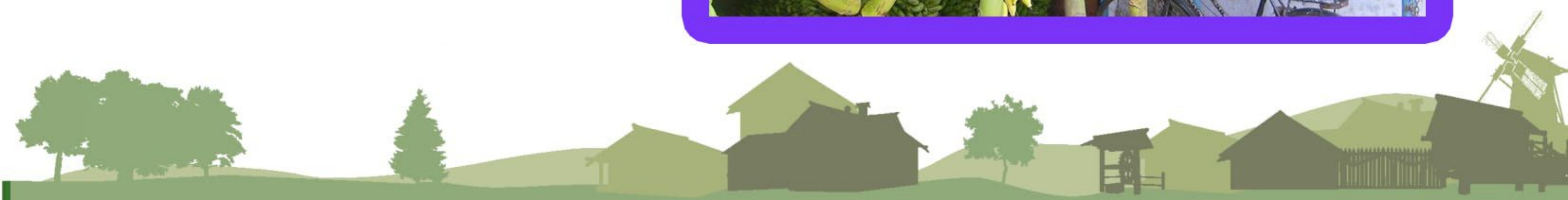
Farmers Producers Organisations

The FPO's Promoted by the Nestham in the year 2015 with support of NABARD under produce fund for the collective and co-operative marketing and generate more income to the farmers, especially Banana farmers, The FPO's are showing significant progressive growth in the agri business. The 5 FPO having 1250 members and 600 shareholders and authorised share capital is Rs. 250 Lakhs and paid up share capital is 25.00 lakhs and the annual turnover is Rs.10 crores. The FPO's established the Customer hiring centres and Input centres to provide better services to the farmers. The FPO is showing visible growth in development of the Agriculture by providing much door step services to the farmers, The farmers are getting remunerative price and access for the marketing in the villages and arranging quality inputs and other extension activities with support of KVK's, Department of Horticulture.

Rural Agriculture Financing Program

The NGO is providing agriculture financial services to the farmers especially small & marginal farmers for the working capital. The last financial year, the Nestham disbursed Rs.50 millions to 2500 farmers especially for the agriculture, horticulture, dairy entrepreneurship development activities.
