




NESTHAM PROFILE

The FPO Promoted by the Nestham in the year 2015 with support of Nabard under produce fund for the collective marketing and cooperative marketing and generate more income to the farmers especially Banana farmers, The FPO's are showing Very much progressive growth in the agric business .The 5 FPO having 35000 members and 1000 shareholders and authorised share capital 250 Lakhs and paid up share capital is 50.00 lakhs and the annual turnover is Rs.15 crores .

The FPO's established the Customer hiring centres and Input centres to provide better services to the farmers. The FPO is showing significant growth in development of the Agriculture by providing much door step services to the farmers, The farmers are getting remunerative price and access for the marketing in the villages and getting qualify inputs and other extension activities with support or KVK's, Department of Horticulture and other activities.

The FPO's are strengthened with the more number of farmers as a members and share holders and provide skill development training to the members for the Production improvement and organisational development.

The Nestham is promoting collective marketing to the farmers to get maximum profit for the commodities. The Nestham Provided 100 lakhs to the 10 FPO's which was received from the NABKISAN for the Working capital.





JLG's Promotion

The Nestham Promoted 250 JLG Groups among small and marginal farmers for the credit support and other necessary activities. The Organisation gave training to the members on the credit activity and credit disciplines.
